ATV NEWS

All ATV trails are closed until June, or until they are useable. In the event that the weather permits an earlier opening an email will be sent to all members informing them. The new ATV trail will be open this year. This trail, which connects the lower and upper roads, was a huge undertaking by several members in the club and they did an outstanding job. The installation of signs will be completed soon.

All members that use an ATV or snowmobile on the club are required, per the lease with F&W, to submit a copy of the registration, and in force insurance to the secretary. Failure to do so could result in a significant fine. The care taker will be provided with a list of members that have submitted the required documents.

DUES AND KEYS

Yearly dues are payable in two installments of \$395. **The 1st installment is due by April 1, 2013**. Notices will be going out on or before March 1st. Senior Membership dues are \$98.75 per installment and due at the same time as the general membership dues. Guest passes have been increased to \$50 as discussed and approved at the fall meeting. Camp fees are \$300. Camp rents will be sent out biannually along with dues notices. Taxes, property and school, have not increased and will remain at \$125 per camp.

CLUB BY-LAW REVISIONS

The new lease from F&W required the club to update our Bylaws to reflect the rules and language of the lease. This was completed last year and approved by the membership at the spring and fall meetings.

Revisions to the Guest Pass were discussed at the fall meeting and the membership voted to maintain the same Guest Pass system that was in the By-Laws. The membership did approve an increase in the fee from \$20 to \$50 per Guest Pass. Also, members may have up to two guests at a time based on the F&W lease provision.

PROPERTY CHAIRMAN AND WORK DAYS

Marshall Zeh, Property Chairman, will be establishing work days and will announce the dates at the Spring Meeting. Also, the dates will be listed in the Summer/Fall 2013 newsletter.
